


Create and Validate Currency Question


Looking to collect a currency (US dollars, Euros, etc.) and validate that the entries are correct? Here's how!

1. Click **Question** at the bottom of the page where you wish to add your currency question. Select **Textbox** from the Question Type dropdown menu and enter your question text.
2. Next, head over the **Validation** tab and select **Currency** in the **Answer Format** dropdown menu.
