


Set Up a Survey Link to Use Your Branded Subdomain

Once you have your [Branded Subdomain](#) set up, you'll want to use it in your survey share links. To do so:

1. Go to the **Share** tab of a project.
2. Click **Customize this link** and select **Branded Subdomain** under **Sub-Type** and select your Branded Subdomain in the dropdown portion of the link that is provided then click **Done** and **Save Link***
3. Test the link! Once you've created a link that uses your Branded Subdomain, test it!

Note: the /s3/ portion of our survey links cannot be removed; this is the identifier that tells our infrastructure to look for a survey.
