

# Can I remove the /s3/ from my survey share link?

Whether you use the Alchemer domain or your own private domain in your share link, you will notice that there is a reference to an s3 directory.

```
https://www.Example.com/s3/1234567/Survey
```

```
https://surveys.Example.com/s3/1234567/Survey
```

The /s3/ portion of the link cannot be removed; this is the reference to the directory where our surveys are stored.
