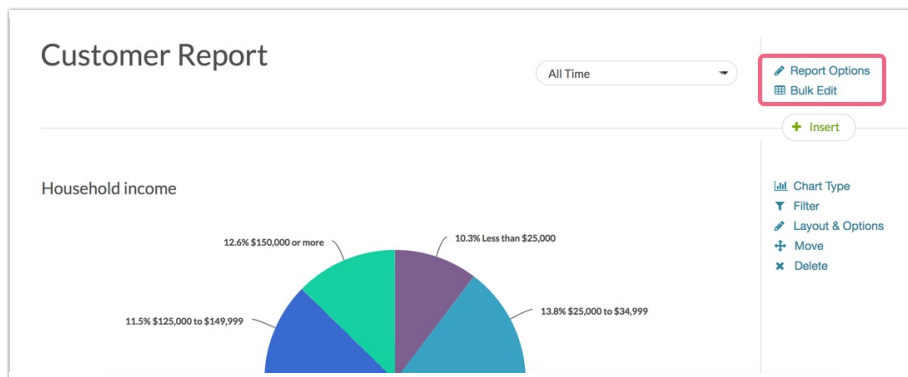


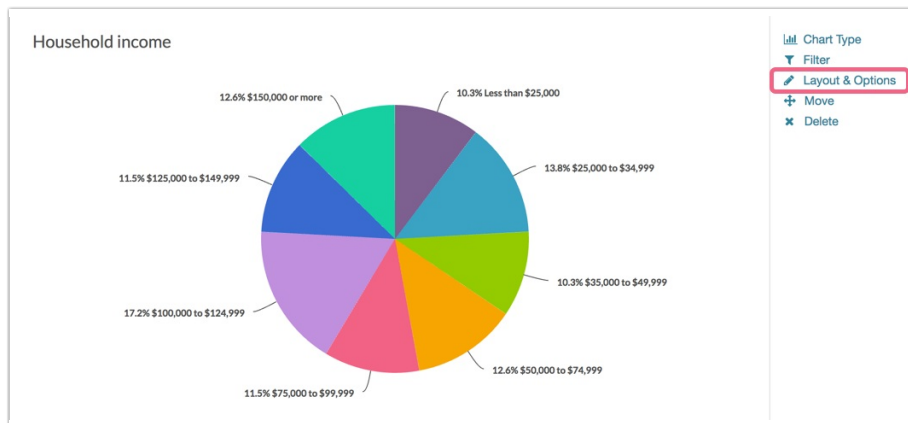
Standard Report: Report Options Vs. Layout & Options

The Standard Report allows you to make edits and changes in a couple of different ways, depending on the scope of the changes that you are looking to make:

1. Use the **Report Options** and **Bulk Edit Elements** tools to change settings for all elements in your report at once. Both of these options can be found in the upper right of your Standard Report.



2. Use **Layout & Options** to customize specific report elements on a case-by-case basis. This option is located to the right of any compatible report element.



Report Options

The Standard Report offers a multitude of overall report settings via **Report Options**. By default, all reporting elements use the overall settings of the Standard Report. Editing an individual element essentially overrides the overall report setting for that element only.

Filter Details

Filter Details are enabled by default and refer to the notification that is shown if a filter is applied to a specific report element.

Household income

Filter: Question "Household income" #2 is one of the following answers ("Less than \$25,000"; "\$25,000 to \$34,999")

Uncheck the **Filter Details** checkbox to remove these notifications for the entire report.

Chart

Enabled by default, Charts refer to the graphical elements in the Standard Report, such as Pie Charts, Bar Charts, etc. Uncheck the **Chart** checkbox to hide charts for the entire report. Report elements will display with only the Summary Table as a result.

Questions With no Data

The Questions With no Data setting allows you to control whether you want to display questions that have not collected any data on your survey. By default, questions with no data will be displayed in your report. Toggle this setting to remove all questions with no data in your Standard Report.

Use Question Alias as Title

The **Question Alias** feature allows you to create short names for your survey's question titles (this is particularly useful for reporting purposes if your question titles are long).

The **Use Question Alias as Title** setting allow you to use these short names as titles in your report. Check this setting to use Question Aliases for all reporting elements (provided that an Alias was configured on your survey's Build tab). This option is disabled by default.

Question Numbering

By default, the reporting elements in your Standard Report will be numbered starting with 1. You have the option to turn off numbering in the report by selecting **No Numbers**. If you have customized the numbering of your survey and want to carry that over into your report, select the **Original Question Number From Survey** option. Last, you have the option to convert numbering into lettering, beginning with the letter A.

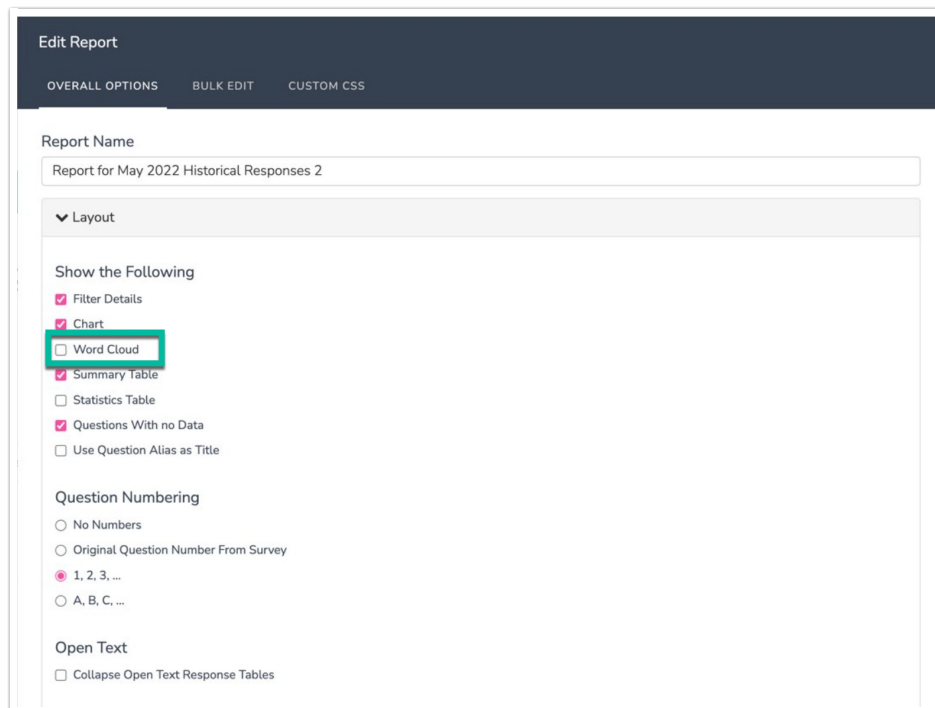

Decimal Places

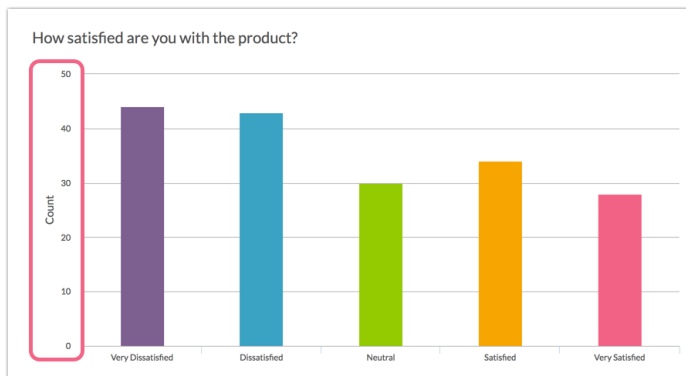

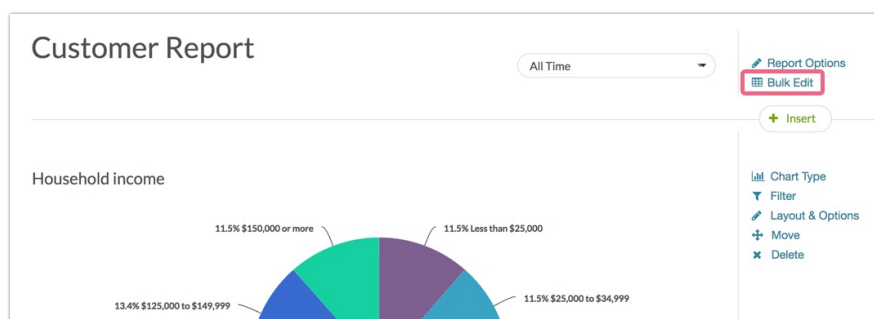

Layout & Options (Individual Report Elements)
