Copy the first bit of code to paste into the HTML of your survey's theme. The HTML of your survey's theme can be found on the **Style** tab of your survey. Scroll to the bottom of the survey preview on the Style tab to access the link to the **HTML/CSS Editor**. On the **Custom HTML** tab

paste the code at the bottom of the HTML.



Next, copy the second bit of code from the Facebook configurator and paste it wherever you would like it to display in your survey (i.e. Text/Instructions element). In our example above, we placed it in the Footer of the survey.
