

Alchemer Release Notes: November 29, 2023

Alchemer Survey

Improvements

[Update] – Customers can now show or hide survey source tags when sharing or downloading reports.

[Update] – The source tags will only display for Cross Survey Standard Reports, and no longer display for single source Standard Reports.

[Update] – All projects a user has access to display in the Source Selector, regardless of filters and folders open on the Project Dashboard.

[Update] – Individual element layout and options are used instead of the overall report options when downloading report to PDF.

[Update] – Customers can now report on individual rows for Radio Button Grid and Checkbox Grid Question.

[Update] – Performance improvements for creating Global Questions in the Question Library.

[Update] – SMTP integration setup allows special characters in the password.

[Update] – JSON validation is now removed from the survey webhook action.

[Update] – JavaScript actions in surveys can now be created/updated/deleted using the v5 APIs.

Fixes

[Fixes] – Fixed an issue where sentiment chart elements from other surveys were not displaying in reports for Essay and Textbox question types.

[Fixes] – Fixed an issue where text or Image elements were inconsistently displaying in the report builder, report viewer of shared links, and in PDF downloads.

[Fixes] – Fixed an issue where the 'Include lists of open text answers' checkbox was not working as expected for PDF downloads.

[Fixes] – Fixed an issue where some customers were unable to add multiple question library items to a survey simultaneously.
