

Set the Y-Axis

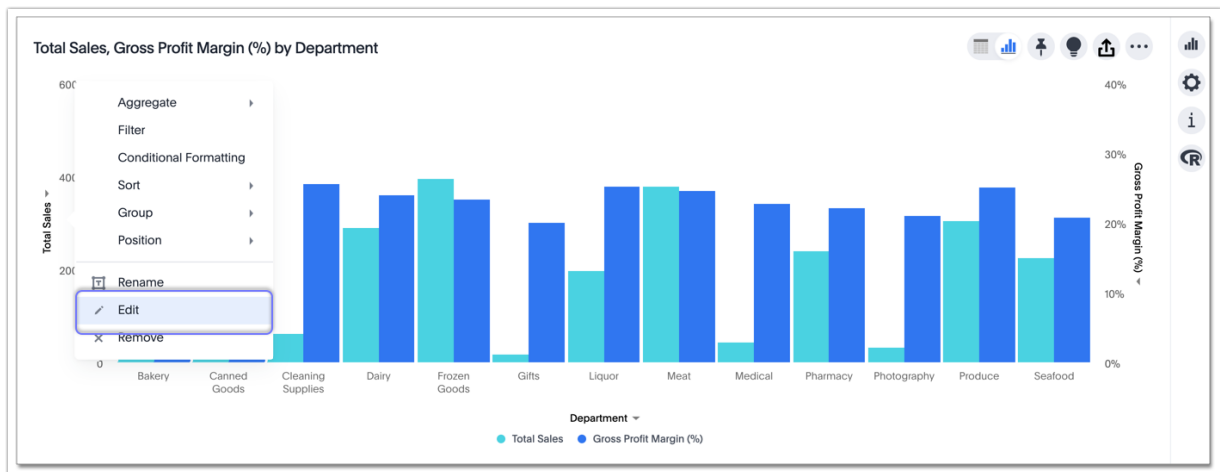
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You can manually set the y-axis range by selecting **edit** from the [y-axis label dropdown menu](#), or from the [chart configuration menu](#).

Setting the y-axis range from the axis label

To set the y-axis range:

1. While viewing your Chart as a chart, open the dropdown menu icon next to the y-axis label you want to change.
2. Select **edit**.

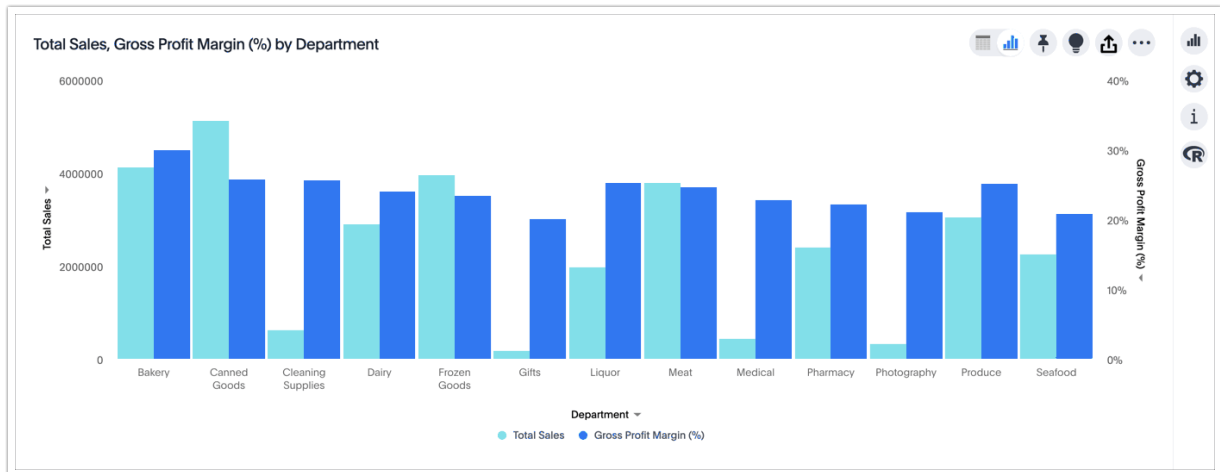


3. Under **Min** and **Max**, set the y-axis range by specifying start and end values.

In this example, the original chart shows **sales** values by **department** from 0 to over \$5M. We can enter a y-axis range of **2500000** to **5000000** to show only sales between \$2.5M and \$5M.

The chart reorganizes itself to reflect the new y-axis range.

To change the range for **gross profit margin**, open the dropdown menu icon next to the **gross profit margin** axis label.



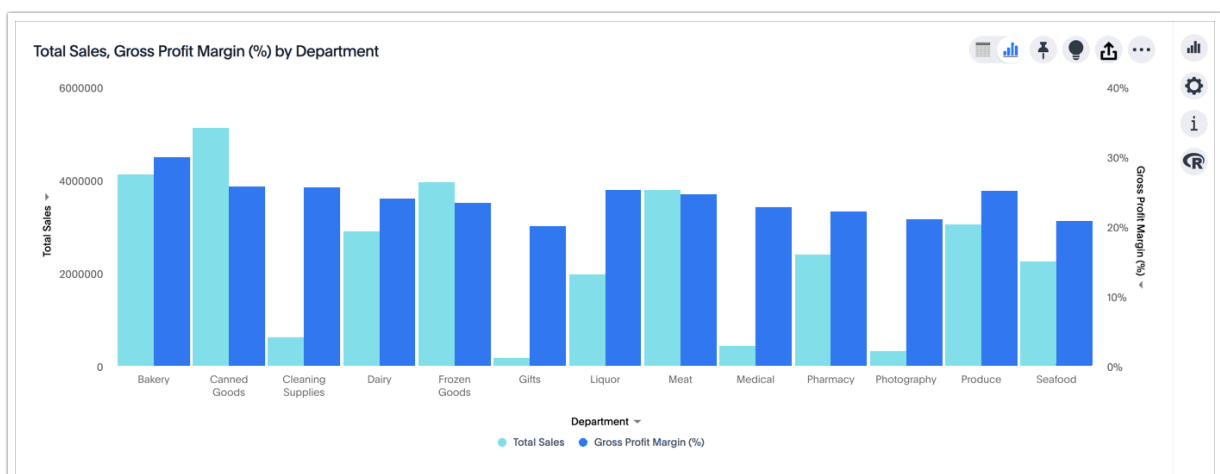
Setting the y-axis range from the chart configuration menu

To set the y-axis range:

1. While viewing your Chart as a chart, select the **chart configuration** icon on the upper right.
2. Select the **edit** button that appears when you hover over **y-axis**.
3. If you have multiple measures on the y-axis, select the measure you want to set the range for.
4. Under **Min** and **Max**, set the y-axis range by specifying start and end values.

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
