## Overview

The Alchemer Swoogo integration uses an API key to authenticate.

## Swoogo API Credentials

### What You Need

- A Swoogo account with API access enabled
  - Swoogo API key and secret
- 

## How to Get Your Swoogo API Credentials

1. **Log in to your Swoogo account.**
2. **Navigate to API settings.**
  - Click your account name in the top right corner.
  - Select **Account Settings**.
  - Select the **API Keys** tab.
3. **Generate a new API key.**
  - Select **Add New Key**.
  - Provide a name for the key (e.g., "Alchemer Integration").
  - Copy the generated API key. Store it securely — you may not be able to view it again after leaving this page.

## Authenticate Swoogo in Alchemer

After obtaining your Swoogo API key, add it to the Alchemer Swoogo integration. Credentials are securely stored in Alchemer and can be reused.

## How to Authenticate

### Your browser does not support HTML5 video.

1. **Start a New Authentication**
  - Inside any Swoogo integration action, select **New Authentication**.
2. **Enter Your Swoogo Credentials**

Provide the following:

  - Swoogo API Consumer key and secret

### 3. Save Your Authentication

- Select **Create**.
- Once created:
  - The authentication is saved and reused for all Swoogo actions
  - You only need to update it if your API credentials change
